



# RULES FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS!!

## Rules for Children

- Be respectful when others are talking.
- Please pick up after yourself.
- Stay in the room unless Zoo staff is with you.
- Leave your gear stowed until activities are over.
- Always walk on Zoo grounds.
- No “Heelies” are allowed on Zoo grounds.
- Follow instructions of Zoo staff during all activities and tours.
- Keep one foot on the floor at all times. No gymnastics.
- Keep your hands and your feet to yourself.
- If you have a cell phone or an electronic game, it must be turned off during the program.

## Rules for Parents/Chaperones/Teachers

- Stay with your group throughout the evening.
- Please assist Zoo staff with **all** activities.
- We ask that all cell phones and electronic equipment be turned off during Zoo Snooze activities so as not to distract the group, instructors, or the animals. If you should need to make a phone call, please step outside of the classroom.
- Chaperones are responsible for all medical needs of the group. A first aid kit is available for needed supplies. If it is a medical emergency, please inform the Zoo Snooze instructors immediately.
- Please be aware that the Memphis Zoo is now a smoke-free facility. If you smoke, please ask the Zoo Snooze instructors where the designated smoking area for the evening is located. Please do not smoke in front of children or around animals. During regular Zoo hours, the designed smoking area is in the main parking lot only.
- **Chaperones are responsible for the behavior of the group! The Zoo Snooze instructors do reserve the right to stop the program at any time due to the behavior of the group.**
