



## Zoo Snooze Supply List – what to bring and what not to bring!

### Bring

Sleeping Bag and Pillow  
Toothbrush and toothpaste  
Comb or Brush  
Pajamas  
Clothes appropriate for the weather  
Washcloth and personal hygiene  
products (You will have access to a  
sink and toilet but not a shower)  
Shoes appropriate for walking  
around the zoo

### Optional

Camera (responsibility of the  
child or parent)  
Foam pad or air mattress  
Sleeping mask for adults

### Do Not Bring

Electronic games  
Stuffed animals  
Expensive jewelry  
Flashlights  
Radios

- Please be prepared for inclement weather. Unless the weather is severe and city schools have been closed, we will continue the program. If the program is canceled due to weather, you will be contacted by a Zoo Educator.
- You should arrive at 6:45 pm in the evening. Please unload your vehicles and bring all of your groups belongings to the front gate. Zoo Snooze instructors will meet you outside the main gate at approximately 7:00 p.m. Once the Zoo Snooze instructors meet you, vehicles will be locked inside Zoo gates for the evening.
- A light snack such as popcorn and lemonade will be served in the evening before bed and a breakfast such as muffins, assorted cereal, milk, orange juice, and coffee will also be provided. You are welcome to bring additional snacks if you wish.
- All Zoo Snoozes will take place in a room with emergency lights that do not allow for complete darkness while sleeping. While the light is dim, participants may consider a sleeping mask.
- Every paying participant will receive a Zoo Snooze t-shirt. Any chaperones who are attending for free will need to purchase their t-shirts at the Elephant's Trunk Gift Shop. Please be sure to include t-shirt sizes on the participant list included in this packet. T-shirt sizes include the following: child small, child medium, child large, adult small, adult medium, adult large, adult extra large, and adult double extra large.
